Mission Statement:

The Kentuckiana GCSA exists to support turfgrass management, provide valuable member services and be viewed as the professional organization promoting and preserving the game of golf.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Kentuckiana Golf Course Superintendent's Association (KGCSA) Legacy Award competition offers education aid to the children and grandchildren of KGCSA members and is administered by The KGCSA Board of Directors. Applications are submitted for judging to an independent committee consisting of three high school educators and/or three college administrators to protect against bias. All decisions of the committee will be final. Applicants will be notified of their status by email. All scholarship award checks will be made payable to the applicant.

ELIGIBILITY

1. One or more of the applicant's parents or grandparents must have been a KGCSA member for five or more consecutive years and must be a currently active KGCSA member. The competition is open to natural or adoptive offspring of KGCSA members. Children or grandchildren of deceased members are also eligible if the member was active at the time of his or her death.
2. The student must be enrolled full-time at an accredited institution of higher learning, or in the case of high school seniors, must be accepted at such an institution for the next academic year. Graduating high school seniors must attach a letter of acceptance to their application.
3. Past *winner*s are ineligible to apply the following year. They may reapply after a one-year hiatus.
4. Although any number of students from the same family may apply, only one student per family per year will be eligible to receive an award.

CRITERIA for SELECTION

1. Applicants will be evaluated based on academic achievement, extracurricular and community involvement, leadership and outside employment.
2. The student must submit an original essay of up to 500 words. The essay must be original and not previously submitted to KGCSA.

NOTE: Financial need is not a factor in the selection.

HOW to APPLY

Students must complete and submit the attached application form and supply the following under one cover:

1. Official transcripts from all high schools and colleges attended.
2. Typed original essay.
3. Graduating high school seniors must attach a collegiate letter of acceptance to their application.
4. All applications must be emailed in PDF form to lisab@kgcsa.info
5. Deadline to submit applications is August 30, 2016

TIPS

Your scholarship application will be judged by its appearance. It is important to remember the following tips:

1. Read the instructions carefully.
2. Request information that you have to obtain from others early.
3. If you have questions, email lisab@kgcsa.info
4. Have your application arrive as early as possible.
5. Provide all the information required. Do not submit an incomplete application.
6. Do not include extra items.
7. Proof all materials. Have one or two other people proof your essay. Use spell check.
8. Be neat. If you need additional pages to fully answer a question, use them.
9. Make copies of your finished application for reference.

CHECK LIST

- Carefully complete each question in application.
- Sign where indicated.
- Attach transcripts from all universities and post-secondary schools that include grades from the last completed semester. The transcripts do not need to be official.
- Attach required essay.
- If you are a graduating high school senior, attach a letter of acceptance from the college you plan to attend.
